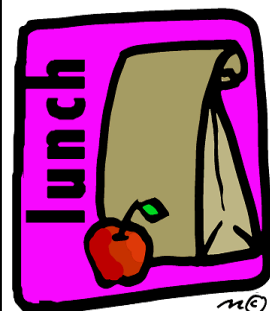
As you will appreciate the next few weeks will become increasingly busy; please make sure you keep a careful eye on the diary.

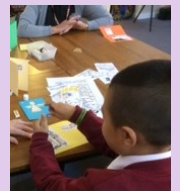
## Frodsham Christmas Festival
