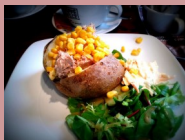

Well done to Anna Hind seen pictured here after she had done the Swimathon on Sunday 7th April

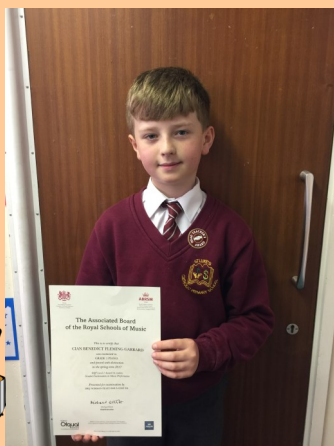
In 1 session, she swam over a mile - 75 lengths!
