

### Safety Central



This week year 5 had a fantastic time at the new Fire Station and Safety Central Education Centre in Lymm. The programmes are targeted at schools, and cover the hazards that they are most likely to encounter. Learning takes place in a series of purpose-built indoor scenarios designed to be realistic, immersive and interactive including:

- a life-size three-bedroom house
- a typical Cheshire 'A' road meandering through an urban and rural setting
- a courtroom, A&E treatment area, shop, police custody suite and e-safety lab
- a farm, railway station, urban park, forest, canal side and open water
- a 360 degree immersive virtual learning zone



The children as you can imagine after experiencing this amazing facility went home and relayed the day to parents:

'My son did not stop talking about it all evening and seems to have really absorbed all the information. He was able to show me how to put someone into the recovery position, look at safety around the house and told me what he would do if he was being bullied online! I was SO impressed.'
