
As always we are very proud of St Luke's for the continued generosity of our parents and children.

Child car seats come in different sizes. It is important that adults choose the right size for their child. If you are not 12 years old or shorter than 135cm you need a booster seat or for the little ones a car seat. However, it's best if you keep your booster seat until you're 150cm. Check you have your seatbelt on, adults ask your children if it's on. Remember—everyone needs to buckle up when they travel.
