



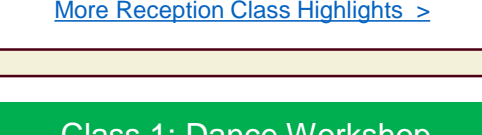

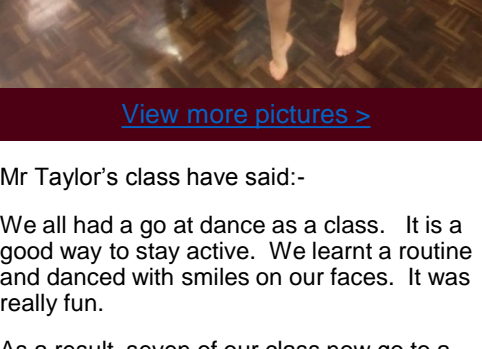

Mr Taylor's class have said:-

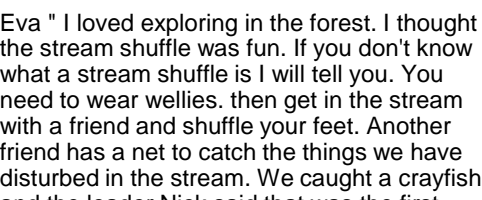
We all had a go at dance as a class. It is a good way to stay active. We learnt a routine and danced with smiles on our faces. It was really fun.

Hana " I enjoyed building the dens, because when we did it we made a see-saw in our garden."

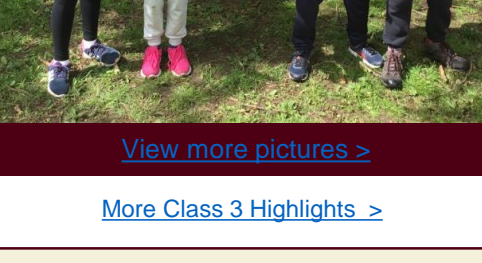

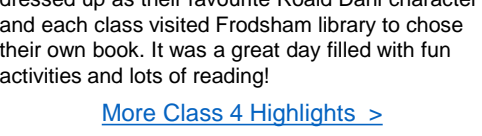

Class 4: Roald Dahl Day

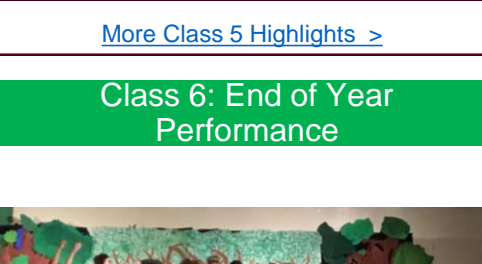

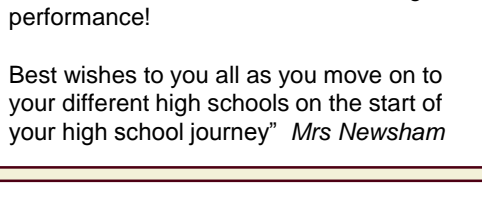
