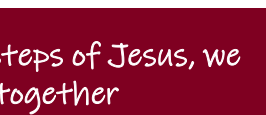
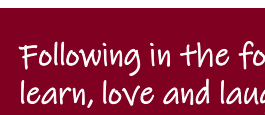
Pupil Premium
