

I Shall Not Want

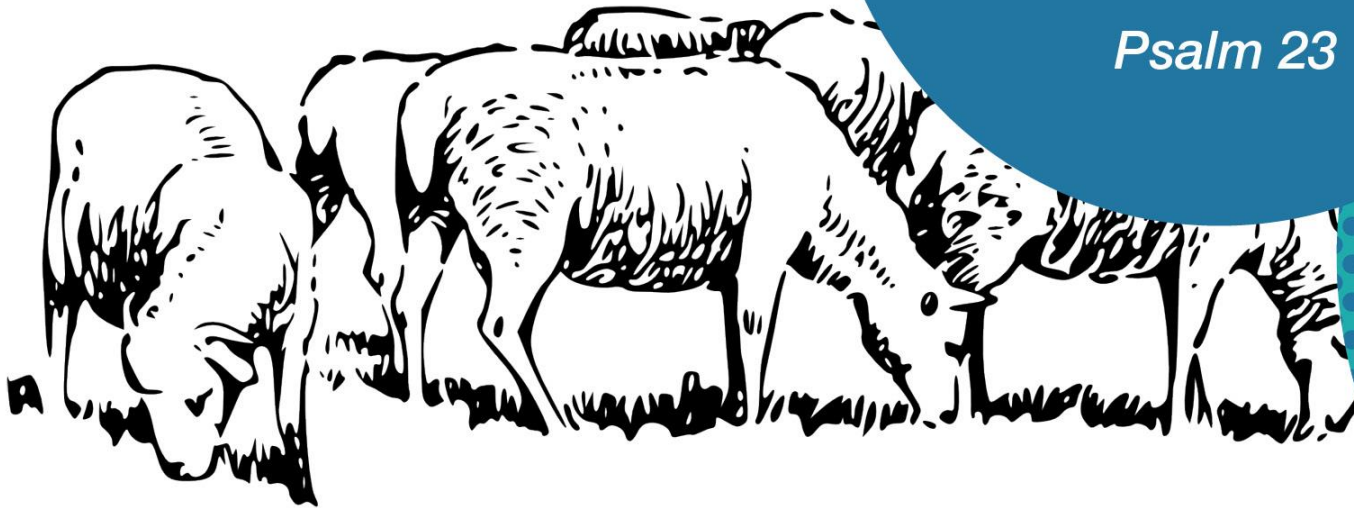

Psalm 23

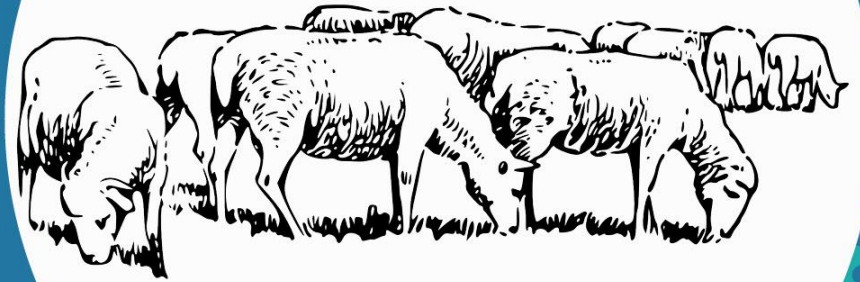


Prayer Leader:

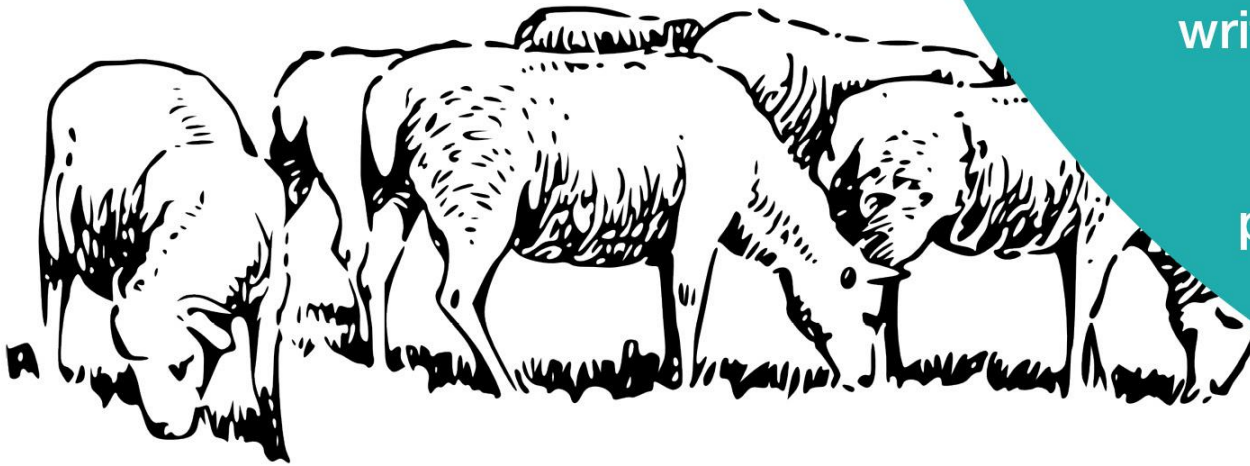
But a sheep isn't very happy without the rest of the flock. Jesus knows that we won't be very happy either if we don't have family, friends and our Church community!
