







Equipment


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Getting to Secondary School




Youp Timetable



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



- c) You've just finished lunch in the dining room and your next lesson is upstairs in S block. You said you'd meet your friend in the break out space and need to use the toilet before the bell goes as well. Which route should you take?
- Congratulations, you've found your way around Helsby. Don't worry, in real life you'll figure it out very quickly and there will be lots of staff and other students to help you on your way around.
