Dear Parents and Carers,

As you are probably aware, all children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 are eligible for Universal Free School Meals. However, some children may eligible to receive Pupil Premium Free School Meals as an alternative. We are asking parents and guardians who's income would entitle them to the Pupil Premium (see the below criteria) to complete this form.

The Pupil Premium is extra money given to your child's school to spend on resources such as one to one tutoring, music lessons, extra curricular clubs and school trips. For 2015/2016 this is **£1320 per pupil**. Funding is based on children registered for a free school meal, further reinforcing the importance of making sure all those who qualify are actually registered.

Please complete all sections on the reverse of this letter if your income meets one of the categories below and either return it to your school or local benefit office, this will be processed in confidence by the Local Authority.

Your child may be entitled to receive Pupil Premium Free School Meals if you are entitled to receive one of the following:

- Income Support
- Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- The Guarantee element of State Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit, provided you are not entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual income that does not exceed £16,190.
- Universal Credit

It is really important that you complete and return this form to help make sure your child's school is funded as well as possible.
